The Historically Black Colleges and Universities Tour provides a unique opportunity to experience first-hand some of our finest Historically Black Colleges and Universities. While on tour, students discover a climate of support in which generations of students have been taught that no one can limit their horizons. Join us for an exciting six day tour!

Tour Director: Barbara Evans – Ms. Evans is a retired Elk Grove Unified School District administrator and has coordinated the HBCU Tour for nine years. She is very knowledgeable, efficient, and experienced in the areas of group travel and tour planning.

The Tour Includes: Roundtrip airfare from Sacramento, six days and five nights hotel accommodations-Embassy Suites/Hilton, Inc., land transportation in air-conditioned motor coaches, campus orientation tours, meetings with college admission officials, daily meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks) adult chaperone ratio of approximately 1 to 10, professional night time security, and pre-departure orientation meetings in Elk Grove/Sacramento, Lodi/Stockton, and Modesto California.

HBCU tour itinerary includes the following colleges and universities:

Tennessee State University, Fisk University, Meharry Medical College, Morehouse College or Spelman College, Clark Atlanta University, Tuskegee University, Alabama State University, Florida A & M State University, Dillard University, and Xavier University

The tour departs Sacramento, CA June 19, 2011 and returns June 24, 2011.

Price: The total price of the tour is \$1690.00. The tour's cost is payable in one payment or installments. (Adult Chaperone price double occupancy is \$1795.00).

Installment Payments: After the initial \$415.00 deposit (\$200.00 non-refundable) is paid, the balance of the tour cost is due in three equal installment payments of \$425.00 each. These payments are **due on or before** the following dates: January 5, March 2, and May 5, 2011. (*The May 5, 2011 meeting will be held at Valley High School in Sacramento, CA for all tour participants.*) Returned checks for insufficient funds and late payments, will be assessed a \$25.00 processing fee (see payment agreement in registration packet).

Cancellation Policy: Refunds (minus the non-refundable deposit and airline ticket) will be made if notice of cancellation is received in writing on or before April 15, 2011. **NO REFUNDS after April 15, 2011**
